May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God our Father and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you to enable you to live a Christ-centered life. Always remember "CHRIST IS COUNTING ON YOU!" and may your response ever be "AND I AM COUNTING ON CHRIST!"
